A Message from Father John:

Our Archbishop, Vincent Nichols has asked all Catholics of England and Wales make the four Fridays of May, days of special prayer of reparation and atonement for the Crimes of Abuse of Children and for the inadequate response of church leaders to these crimes.

We are invited to come before the Blessed Sacrament to pray to God for healing, forgiveness and a renewal dedication. To pray for all who have suffered abuse, for all who were not believed, for all who mishandled these matters and added to the suffering of those affected and for all who committed these crimes of abuse. In Our Lady of Lourdes we pray in adoration before the Blessed Sacrament every Friday of the year. Please come and join us.

On Friday 7th May we are having our first **Night Vigil of Prayer** starting at 10.30pm. Please do come and join us. This is also the 1st Friday of the month.

First Friday Devotion requirements – In 1675, Our Lord appeared “out of a monsternace” before St Margaret Mary Alacoque and showed the burning love of his Heart for men. After revealing the now famous promises to those who would venerate his Sacred Heart, Our Lord said: “The all powerful love of my heart will grant to those who shall receive Communion on the First Friday of nine consecutive months the grace of final repentance ..” **Those who honour Our Lord in his Sacred Heart by attending Mass and receiving Communion for nine consecutive First Fridays would receive many graces from the Heart of Jesus and would not die without receiving the Sacraments. A final promise was that the Sacred Heart would be an “assured refuge at the last hour”.**
