Theft in the Church

Update on the Parish Hall development

We are still awaiting a response from Ealing Council Planning department. They seem to move very slowly. The Diocese have approved our request for a loan to do the work, for which we are very grateful. We will keep you informed.

First Holy Communion – The First Holy Communions will be held at the 10.30am and 12 noon masses on June 6th and June 13th

Tea and Coffee after Sunday mass – each week after the 9.00am and 10.30am masses, we have tea and coffee served in the hall. You are very welcome to go along and meet the parishioners. Religious books, cards etc are often available. Thanks to all those who serve the tea and coffee on Sunday's.

Hymn Books – each week hymns are sung at the 9.00am, 10.30am and 12 noon masses on Sunday. We would encourage you to use the hymn books as the hymns are chosen to correspond with the readings of the day. To sing well is to pray twice and you will be supporting the liturgy and music groups who are so generous with their time.

There will be a second collection today for the Papal visit. The visit has both State and pastoral aspects. The Holy Father is coming at the invitation of Her Majesty the Queen and the Prime Minister, and the Visit will include a number of state engagements. There will also be a number of pastoral events, culminating with the beatification of Cardinal Newman at a major open air mass at Coventry Airport on Sunday 19th September. The cost of such a visit are significant. The State elements are properly the reconcilability of the government to meet, but quite right the Church will need to meet the costs of the pastoral aspects of the Visit. The Church is working on plans for these events which will leave a lasting legacy for the Church in England, Scotland and Wales. To help meet these costs of around £7m. We ask you to be as generous as you can. There are envelopes available from the back of the church and also prayer cards.
