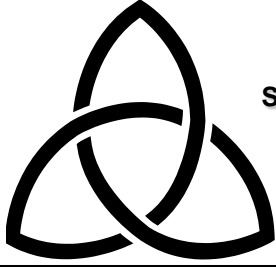

**First Friday Devotion requirements** – In 1675, Our Lord appeared to St Margaret Mary Alacoque and showed the burning love of his Heart for men. After revealing the now famous promises to those who would venerate his Sacred Heart, Our Lord said: "The all powerful love of my heart will grant to those who shall receive Communion on the First Friday of nine consecutive months the grace of final repentance .." **Those who honour Our Lord in his Sacred Heart by attending Mass and receiving Communion for nine consecutive First Fridays would receive many graces from the Heart of Jesus and would not die without receiving the Sacraments. A final promise was that the Sacred Heart would be an "assured refuge at the last hour"**.

**Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> June is the first Saturday of the month.** We encourage you to pray the first Saturday Devotion, requirements as follows – On December 10, 1925, Our Lady appeared with the Child Jesus to Lucia at the Dorothean convent in Pontevedra, Spain (now a retreat centre owned and administered by the World Apostolate of Fatima). Our Lord asked Lucia to "Have pity" on The Heart of her "Most Holy Mother" and to offer acts of reparation. Then Our Lady said "Look, my daughter, at my heart encircled With thorns, with which ungrateful men pierce it at every moment by their blasphemies and ingratitude. You, at least, try to console me, and say that I promise to assist at the hour of death with all the graces necessary for the salvation all those who, **on the First Saturday of five consecutive months, confess, receive Holy Communion, recite five decades of the rosary and keep me company for fifteen minutes meditating on the mysteries of the Rosary, with the intention of making reparation to me"**.
